Aims and Objectives of the Artisans' Guild: The Guild was formed to promote a community interest and improve skills in the traditional arts, to provide a venue for people in the Caboolture district to display and sell their arts and crafts and to provide a meeting place for people with similar interests. We work closely with all local art and craft groups and with local charities to assist in their activities. Our motto, "*Discordia Frangimur*" is Latin for *Discord Weakens* and was chosen to encourage our members to work in unison even though they may have diverse interests.



Who Can Join the Artisans' Guild: We represent a wide range of visual arts and crafts; all styles of painting, sculpture, hand and wheel thrown pottery, wood, metal and glass works, and all types of hand crafts. All are welcome.

### Classes of Membership:

1. **Full Members** have display sale and voting rights and must be 18 years or over.
2. **Family Full Member** – two full members in one household – same rights but only one newsletter sent.
3. **Junior Members** have display and sale rights, but cannot vote – age 8-17 years.
4. **Associate Member** – for those who are not artisans but wish to support the Guild – no display, sale or voting rights, but receive newsletter and entitled to special prices for outings.
5. **Group Member** – for other groups to become part of the Guild. Group members have one vote at General Meetings and have pre-arranged display rights.

## Guild Activities:

1. Meetings are held monthly.
2. A newsletter is published regularly and sent to all members advising activities, by post or email (if you supply an email address).
3. An annual competitive art show in October/November is the highlight of our year.
4. Members attend local fetes, shows and shopping centre exhibitions, promoting our art and craft.
5. Lessons and workshops are arranged with qualified tutors to enable members to expand their knowledge and improve their skills.
6. Excursions are arranged for outdoor painting to various locations. Regular functions and informal get-togethers are also arranged.
7. The Caboolture Shire Council has generously supported the Guild in establishing the Old Fire Station Art and Craft Gallery, where we display work from members, local artists and craftspeople, as well as travelling exhibitions.



## Work Sold on Commission:

1. All work submitted to the Artisans' Guild for sale on commission must be certified to be the property and creation of the artist, and to not breach any copyright laws.
2. Commission charged by the Artisans' Guild is set according to the Policies and Procedures Manual.
3. The Old Fire Station Gallery is fitted with a fully supervised security system, and all care will be taken, however the Artisans' Guild will not be held responsible for any loss or damage to any work left for sale on commission. Owners of work submitted should contact their own insurers to arrange extended insurance coverage whilst the work is on display in the Gallery.
4. All reasonable efforts will be made to sell work submitted for sale on commission, however the Artisans' Guild cannot guarantee that any particular work will be displayed for sale. The Gallery Committee is responsible for the selection and arrangement of work displayed. Work not displayed for sale will be stored in a secure area until required for display or until collected by the owner.
